Stay Health & Avoid Fraud, Waste, and Abuse - Senior Medicare Patrol (SMP)

Senior Medicare Patrol programs help Medicare and Medicaid beneficiaries prevent, detect, and report health care fraud. In doing so, they not only protect residents, but they also help preserve the integrity of the Medicare and Medicaid programs. Because this work often requires face-to-face contact to be most effective, MMAP Counselors are also your SMP. This session will also cover ways to prevent disease and ensure peace of mind with Medicare's Preventative services.

Your Initial Enrollment into Medicare

Medicare Annual Open Enrollment Review Process

Wednesday, October 11th from 7:00 pm to 8:30 pm

There are multiple review periods. Each annual open review timeline covers different coverage types. Those being Medicare Medigap/Supplement, Medicare Part D Prescription Drug Plan and Medicare Advantage Plans. This session will educate you on the timeline review process applicable to you by MMAP.

Medicare Annual Open Enrollment One on One Review

Wednesday, November 29th from 11:00 am to 3:30 pm

What plan changes can I make during the Medicare open enrollment period, if you're already enrolled in Medicare coverage – you can:

- Switch from Original Medicare to Medicare Advantage (as long as you're enrolled in both Medicare Part A and Part B, and you live in the Medicare Advantage plan's service area).
- Switch from Medicare Advantage to Original Medicare (plus a Medicare Part D plan, and possibly a Medigap plan, although medical underwriting might be required for Medigap, depending on the state and the person's circumstances).
- Switch from one Medicare Advantage plan to another.
- Switch from one Medicare Part D prescription drug plan to another.
- Enroll in a Medicare Part D plan if you didn't enroll when you were first eligible for Medicare. If you haven't maintained other creditable coverage, a late-enrollment penalty may apply.
- TSA / MMAP Certified Medicare Counselors will be on site to assist in your reviews.
