Funeral Lunch

Terri reported for Helen. All is going well and we have a few new volunteers over the past couple months.

Knight of Columbus

Both Ray & Dan reported that things are going well. Weekend of February 3 & 4 there will be a *Coats For Kids Drive*. Not asking for coats, but for donations to purchase them from a vendor who is giving them an incredible deal. This is the same weekend of Pizza Night and Spaghetti Dinner and they plan to have someone attend each event. February 25th in the annual Chili Cook Off. Holding their Regional Meeting in the Parish Hall on Monday, January 22; dinner followed by the meeting. We haven't held the Regional Meeting here in several years.

Outreach

The charities helped this Christmas with gifts and gift cards donated by our generous parishioners were *Loaves and Fishes of Southwest Detroit*, *Franciscan Ministries of Detroit*, and *Vista Maria* in Dearborn Heights. On December 11 Outreach volunteers sorted these donated gifts for about for 135 children for *Loaves & Fishes* and untold number of girls at Vista Maria; total number of children receiving gifts in some form was likely in the 250 range. Also collected were food items for *Loaves and Fishes* and grocery gift cards for the Christian Service Office to distribute to individuals in need. *Franciscan Ministries* specifically requested gift cards for Costco, Gordon Foods and Walmart; total dollar amount of cards donated to them was \$2000-plus. Collection of returned donated gift cards by way of a new lock box outside of the Christian Service Office as well as to "Christmas Carol" by the Giving Tree at all Masses before the December 10 deadline was highly successful and appreciated by parishioners.

Gospel of Life

The AAA Pregnancy Resource Center Baby Bottle Campaign October 2023 has brought in \$7,012 so far. 300 bottles were taken and 27 still need to be returned. Father Jim made an announcement last weekend. Lighthouse Mission Warming Center is open January 1 thru March 31, 2024. It is at Full Gospel Temple Church in Westland. Mike Willis made a Sign Up Genius for volunteers. Tuesday is the day we will be there, 6-11pm. Patti Kelly has helped with details and using her expertise to make this volunteer opportunity easier. The first weekend of Lent Almsgiving charity will be Lighthouse Mission. The following are requested items: paper plates and paper soup bowls, white men's socks, winter hats and gloves for men and women (new or gently used).

Livonia Cares has donated \$500 to Lighthouse Mission for a new freezer after theirs broke and wasn't repairable.

Parish Council

Christmas Masses went well including the 4:00 PM Mass with the overflow in the Parish Hall which was full. Worship will be looking into having altar servers' attendance confirmed especially for Christmas and Easter Masses.

Various methods of welcoming newly registered parishioners was discussed.

Parish office will provide as often as possible the phonetic spelling of names to be read during Prayers of the Faithful.
